BREAK DOWN OF MEMBER NON-RESIDENT FEES / NEW MEMBER

INTERNATIONAL MEMBERSHIP FEE: _____ \$100.00/YEAR

This is an international sorority obligation to be paid once a year in an installment of \$100.00 paid by initiated members only.

CHAPTER FEE: _____ \$900.00/YEAR

Chapter fees cover the costs of all chapter operations, programming costs, social functions, campus activities, recruitment expenses, philanthropic events, etc.

PARLOR/HOUSE FEES: _____ \$960.00/YEAR

This fee covers all of the house expenses that are shared equally by non-resident members. It includes formal Monday night dinners and two lunches per week. The House Corporation Board provides for the annual service and maintenance of the chapter computer system and computer lab. They will provide at least one computer terminal with Internet access for the general use of resident and non-resident members. The computer lab provides wired Internet connections for live-in members, and wireless internet access is provided throughout the house. Members are responsible for the repair and operation of their personal computers, including the computer's ability to access the network. Any technician hired by the Member is at the Member's sole cost and responsibility. The House Corporation Board will cover the cost of the Technology fee for the pledge year.

Members are responsible for all services provided directly to them by outside vendors.

BUILDING FUND: _____ \$270.00/YEAR

This fund is utilized for future housing needs and capital improvements.

KEY DEPOSIT: _____ \$15.00/YEAR

A deposit will be collected to cover the replacement cost of the house key card. If the member returns the original key card at the end of the year, the deposit will be refunded. If the key card is lost during the course of the year, a new key card will be issued, but the deposit will not be refunded.

BADGE: _____ Base rate of \$75.00

Price depends on choice of badge and is determined by each member. Each member must purchase a badge prior to initiation.

NEW MEMBER FEE: _____ \$70.00/YEAR

A portion of this money is remitted to International Headquarters for membership supplies and for the International Building Fund.

INITIATION FEE: _____ \$110.00/YEAR

Includes lifetime membership in Gamma Phi Beta and is remitted to International Headquarters for costs of chapter installation and operations.
