

ALPHA IOTA CHAPTER OF GAMMA PHI BETA SORORITY
2011-2012 MEMBERSHIP CONTRACT

(Return to Carly Cameron, FVP)

I, _____, agree to be a Member of the Alpha Iota Chapter of Gamma Phi Beta SorORITY, for the school year beginning in September 2011, and concluding in June 2012.

As a Member of the Gamma Phi Beta SorORITY, I understand that I must comply with the Gamma Phi Beta International and the Alpha Iota Chapter House Rules and Regulations, including the Alcohol and Visitation policies, and that I must be a member in good standing at all times. Failure to comply with the House Rules and Regulations or be a member in good standing may result in disciplinary action, probation or dismissal from the Gamma Phi Beta SorORITY and/or removal from the chapter house if I am a resident.

I hereby agree to make all payments to Alpha Iota of Gamma Phi Beta, Inc. on or before the specified due date(s) as specified in the Financial Payment Plan Agreement. I have selected the (annual/monthly/quarterly) _____ payment plan from the available payment plans, and I have attached the Financial Payment Plan Agreement. Payments may be made by check, cashier's check, money order, or electronic credit card on or before the due dates listed in the Financial Payment Plan Agreement. If I choose either the Monthly or Quarterly Payment Plan, I understand that it will be my responsibility to make timely payments either to the financial office designated by Alpha Iota of Gamma Phi Beta, Inc. or on-line at www.gammaphibetaalphaiota.org. If the financial office of Gamma Phi Beta has not received any payment within seven (7) days of the due date, a late fee in the amount of \$50 per each late payment will be assessed for member dues (late rent charges will accrue separately according to the housing contract), and I will not be considered a "member in good standing" until the account is brought current. Additionally, I understand that my Financial Aid and/or Scholarship status does not in any way relieve me or the financially responsible party from making all payments in a timely manner as outlined in the payment schedule.

Gamma Phi Beta shall provide an Internet network connection for Members only. The network is designed to facilitate the sharing of knowledge and information, while supporting and enhancing the educational and research experience of the Members. Access to the Gamma Phi Beta provided Internet is a privilege and requires that individuals act responsibly. IT IS AGREED THAT:

- a. Gamma Phi Beta shall provide Members with access to the Internet to the best of its ability. This service is provided for Members' educational research and incidental personal use provided such use does not interfere with the operation of the technology or burden Gamma Phi Beta with incremental costs or excess bandwidth utilization.
- b. Gamma Phi Beta cannot assure complete electronic security or privacy for personal computing. However, it shall do its best to implement basic security and privacy measures as part of routing operations to help protect from service degradation and from the effect of illegal activity such as computer attacks. These measures may include, but are not limited to, routine testing of services and facilities, monitoring for activity patterns commonly indicating misuse and temporary or permanent limits on bandwidth consistent with maintaining stable and reliable services.
- c. Member acknowledges that service interruptions may occur from time to time due to technical malfunctions or service provider difficulties. Gamma Phi Beta will make its best efforts to provide an uninterrupted service.
- d. Member shall take reasonable security and privacy precautions to protect against computer viruses, worms, Trojan Horses, and other computer attacks which may result in loss of data, unintentional release of personal information, or negative impact on the services and facilities for others. Member is required to have a current anti-virus protection service and must regularly update her computer for virus, worm and Trojan Horse protection. In the event a Member does not have a current protection subscription or service, any damage to the Network due to a virus, worm, Trojan Horse or other attack due to Member's failure to maintain said protection, shall be the responsibility of the Member and Gamma Phi Beta may

- seek reimbursement for any and all costs incurred due to said damages. Member agrees that her computer may be inspected by House Corporation Board or authorized technician, at any time, without further notice, to ensure that the Member's anti-virus protection is current.
- e. Members shall receive a password to access the wireless service and shall keep the password confidential at all times. Gamma Phi Beta may change the password periodically to protect the security of the system. Updated passwords will be provided to Members only.
 - f. The Member shall not utilize or allow "file sharing" programs as such programs utilize large amounts of bandwidth and result in service interruptions. The Member shall disallow or "turn-off" all access for uploading files.
 - g. The Member shall be held accountable for her own behavior and for any inappropriate activity originating from her room or computer, including any fines or assessments that Gamma Phi Beta incurs due to illegal or unauthorized activity. All passwords should be secure, and the Member is solely responsible for the activity on her computer. Any illegal activity may be punishable by law.
 - h. The Member shall abide by all applicable laws (state and federal) and University policies, including, but not limited to, CTS, ORL, etc. Discipline ranges from loss of network privileges, fines, Member not in good standing, and termination of membership.

As a Member of Gamma Phi Beta Sorority, I understand that any undergraduate member of the Alpha Iota Chapter returning to the University for the purpose of entering school, regardless of the number of course hours carried, must live in the Chapter house, when there is space available, or forfeit all rights and privileges as a member of the Alpha Iota Chapter of Gamma Phi Beta, and is subject to international probation and/or international expulsion by International Council. Moving out of the Chapter house without the required approval of the Alpha Iota of Gamma Phi Beta House Corporation Board also will subject the member to international probation and/or international expulsion by the International Council.

I, a Member of the Alpha Iota Chapter of Gamma Phi Beta (and her parent or guardian if she is a minor), do hereby release Alpha Iota of Gamma Phi Beta, Inc., the Gamma Phi Beta Sorority, and all of its officers, directors, advisors, and employees, from all claims and demands for damages by reason of loss of personal property or by reason of personal injury arising out of or in connection with my membership.

I, a Member of the Alpha Iota Chapter of Gamma Phi Beta (and her parent or guardian if she is a minor) expressly agrees that at the request of Gamma Phi Beta, The University of California, Los Angeles may hold the student records of a Member for failure to pay, when due, all room rental, food charges, dues and other fees that apply uniformly to all members of the organization. By signing this Contract, the Member (and her parent or guardian if she is a minor) hereby expressly authorizes the University to place a hold on my student records with full knowledge that the hold denies the student access to his/her transcript of academic records, and precludes her from continued enrollment in the University. This hold does not impair or limit Gamma Phi Beta from taking legal action with respect to the unpaid obligations for which the hold was made. The hold procedure is applicable and shall remain after the Member ceases to be a continuing student at UCLA and until such time the chapter removes the hold.

If any legal action or proceeding is brought by either party of this Contract the prevailing party shall be reimbursed for all reasonable attorneys' fees and costs in addition to other damages awarded. Due to the ever-increasing fees that can be charged by attorneys, it is agreed by the parties that both sides will waive their right to a jury trial.

Pursuant to section 1785.26 of the California Civil Code, as required by law, I, a Member of the Alpha Iota Chapter of Gamma Phi Beta, Financially Responsible Party and/or Guardian, am hereby notified that a negative credit report reflecting on my credit record may be submitted to a credit reporting agency, if I fail to fulfill the term of my credit obligations.

All notices to Member shall be served at Member's room or sorority mailing address and all notices to Gamma Phi Beta/Authorized person shall be served to: Carly Cameron, 616 Hilgard Ave., Los Angeles, CA 90024 or as otherwise directed by Gamma Phi Beta.

This Contract, the Financial Payment Agreement, and Housing Agreement if applicable, constitutes the entire Agreement between Gamma Phi Beta and all below signatories, including the Member, the Financially Responsible Party, and the Guardian. No oral agreements have been entered into, and all modifications or notices shall be in writing to be valid.

I hereby certify that I have read and understand all of the terms and conditions, fees, and dues owed by me as specified in this Contract and the Financial Payment Plan Agreement to maintain my membership in the Alpha Iota of Gamma Phi Beta sorority, and that I assume liability of all financial obligations thereof and guarantee the faithful performance of the terms stated herein and the payment of all bills.
