ROOM DEPOSIT/SECURITY DEPOSIT: _____ \$100.00/YEAR

ALREADY PAID AND NOT CALCULATED IN THE TOTAL BELOW

A room deposit fee will be collected in May 2011 from each member who desires to live-in the sorority house and will secure her reservation for the 2011-2012 academic year. In the event the member does not move-in, this deposit is non-refundable. This fee will serve as a security deposit, which will be refunded to the member if all furnishings and fixtures in her room are left in proper condition at the end of the year.
